15-13 - Special Home Occupation Provision

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LAST AMENDED 8/27/1998

- (a) In C6 Districts, the #home occupation# provisions of Section <u>12-10</u> (DEFINITIONS Home occupation) shall apply, except that up to 49 percent of the total #floor area# of a #dwelling unit# may be used for a #home occupation#.
- (b) In C5 and C6 Districts, in Manhattan, in the area south of Murray Street and its easterly prolongation and the Brooklyn Bridge, the #home occupation# provisions of Section <u>12-10</u> shall apply, except that up to 49 percent of the total #floor area# of a #dwelling unit# may be used for a #home occupation#.

In addition:

- (1) businesses operated as #home occupations# may have up to three non-#residential# employees; and
- (2) notwithstanding the listing of specific #uses# prohibited in the definition of #home occupations# in Section <u>12-10</u>, a #home occupation# may include any permitted #commercial# #use#, except beauty parlors, veterinary medicine and those #uses# listed in Use Group 12.

Such #home occupation# may occupy more than 500 square feet of #floor area# and, for the purposes of this Section, mezzanines shall be counted as #floor area#.
