128-11 - Ground Floor Uses on Commercial Streets

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LAST AMENDED 10/23/2008

Map 2 (Commercial Streets) in the Appendix to this Chapter specifies locations where the special ground floor #use# regulations of this Section apply.

#Uses# on the ground floor of a #building# shall be limited to #commercial# #uses#, except for Type 1 lobbies and entrances to #accessory# parking spaces provided in accordance with Section <u>37-33</u> (Maximum Width of Certain Uses). Such #commercial# #uses# shall comply with the minimum depth provisions of Section <u>37-32</u> (Ground Floor Depth Requirements for Certain Uses). In addition, #accessory# parking spaces, including such spaces #accessory# to #residences#, shall be permitted on the ground floor, provided they comply with the provisions of Section <u>37-35</u> (Parking Wrap and Screening Requirements). The level of the finished floor of such ground floor shall be located not higher than two feet above nor lower than two feet below the as-built level of the adjoining #street#.
