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136-41 - Parking Regulations

LAST AMENDED 9/7/2017

The off-street parking regulations shall be modified, as follows:

- (a) The regulations of Section <u>25-027</u> (Applicability of regulations in Community District 14, Queens) shall not apply. In lieu thereof, the regulations of the applicable underlying district shall apply, as modified by the provisions of this Section.
- (b) In a C2 District mapped within an R7-1 District, the regulations of Section 25-251 (Income-restricted housing units) shall be modified to require an #accessory# off-street parking requirement of 25 percent per #income-restricted housing unit#.
- (c) For #commercial# #uses# in Parking Requirement Categories PRC-A, PRC-B, PRC-B1 and PRC-C, the provisions of Section <u>36-21</u> (General Provisions) shall be modified to require #accessory# off-street parking spaces at a rate of one parking space per 750 square feet of #floor area#.

For ambulatory diagnostic or treatment health care facilities listed in Use Group 4, the provisions of Sections 25-31 (General Provisions) and 36-21 shall be modified to require #accessory# off-street parking spaces at a rate of one parking space per 750 square feet of #floor area#.

(d) Within Subdistrict A, parking spaces provided on private streets shall count towards the number of #accessory# offstreet parking spaces required by the provisions of Sections <u>36-20</u> (REQUIRED ACCESSORY OFF-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR COMMERCIAL OR COMMUNITY FACILITY USES) and <u>36-30</u> (REQUIRED ACCESSORY OFF-STREET PARKING SPACES FOR RESIDENCES WHEN PERMITTED IN COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS). For such parking spaces located within private streets, the provisions of Section <u>28-40</u> (PARKING FOR QUALITY HOUSING) shall not apply.
