73-212 - Projection of accessory signs

LAST AMENDED 12/15/1961

In C2, C4, C6 or C8 Districts, the Board of Standards and Appeals may permit not more than one #sign accessory# to an #automotive service station#, to project across a #street line# more than the amount permitted in Section <u>32-652</u> (Permitted projection in all other Commercial Districts), but in no case more than four feet, provided that the following findings are made:

- (a) That projection in the amount permitted is required for adequate advance identification of such #automotive service station# to motorists on heavily traveled #streets# in the interests of traffic safety.
- (b) That such #sign# conforms to all other applicable district #sign# regulations, and its total #surface area# is not more than 30 square feet.
